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Annual Reports for Women Empowerment Cell and Sexual harassment & Prevention Cell 2023-24

- **Meeting on Women’s Issues and Facilities:** A meeting was organized on behalf of the Women Empowerment Cell and the Sexual Harassment Prevention Cell. The Principal of Tunga Mahavidyalaya, along with all committee members, attended the meeting. The attendees discussed various issues and facilities related to women and provided suggestions for addressing these concerns.
- **Orientation Program on 27th July 2023:** On 27th July 2023, an orientation program was conducted for all first-year B.Com, B.A, and BCA students. The Women Empowerment Cell aimed to create awareness about students' rights and responsibilities, offering guidance on tackling issues they might face. The program also provided instructions about college facilities, the proper use of restrooms, and information on women's rights. The program was attended by the entire committee, the in-charge Principal, Dr. R. Kumaraswamy, and 38 female students.
- **Arvina Payana and Gender Sensitization Workshop on 2nd December 2023:** The Arvina Payana and Gender Sensitization workshop was held in the Seminar Hall on 2nd December 2023. The event was inaugurated by Dr. K. Anjanappa, Principal of TNVT, along with members of the Karnataka State Federation of Women Against Atrocities, Shimoga, Dr. Kumaraswamy, IQAC Coordinator, and Dr. Deepa L., Coordinator of the Women Empowerment Cell and Sexual Harassment Prevention Cell. Smt. Rekhambha, a member of the Karnataka State Federation Against Atrocities, delivered an inspiring speech on gender discrimination, women’s reservations, sexual harassment, education, and color differentiation. She also interacted with students, sharing real-life stories to illustrate her points.

Dr. Anjanappa, Principal of TMVT, presided over the program and emphasized that every woman has the right to equality and self-expression under the constitution. The program
